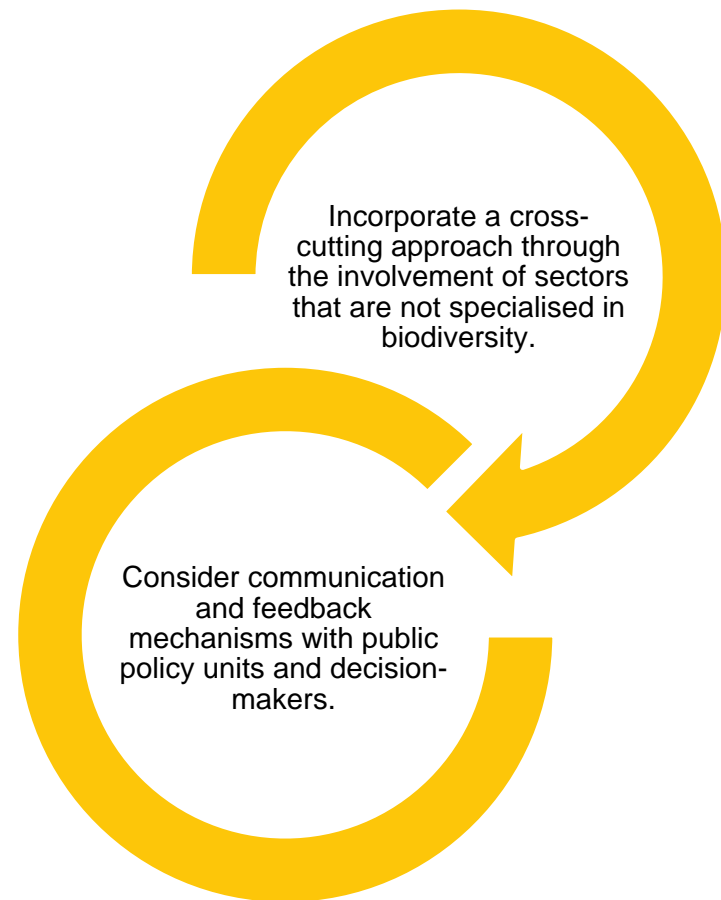
Incorporate complementary capacities and knowledge to those we already have.

Make biodiversity more visible, by involving new non-specialist actors in the projects.

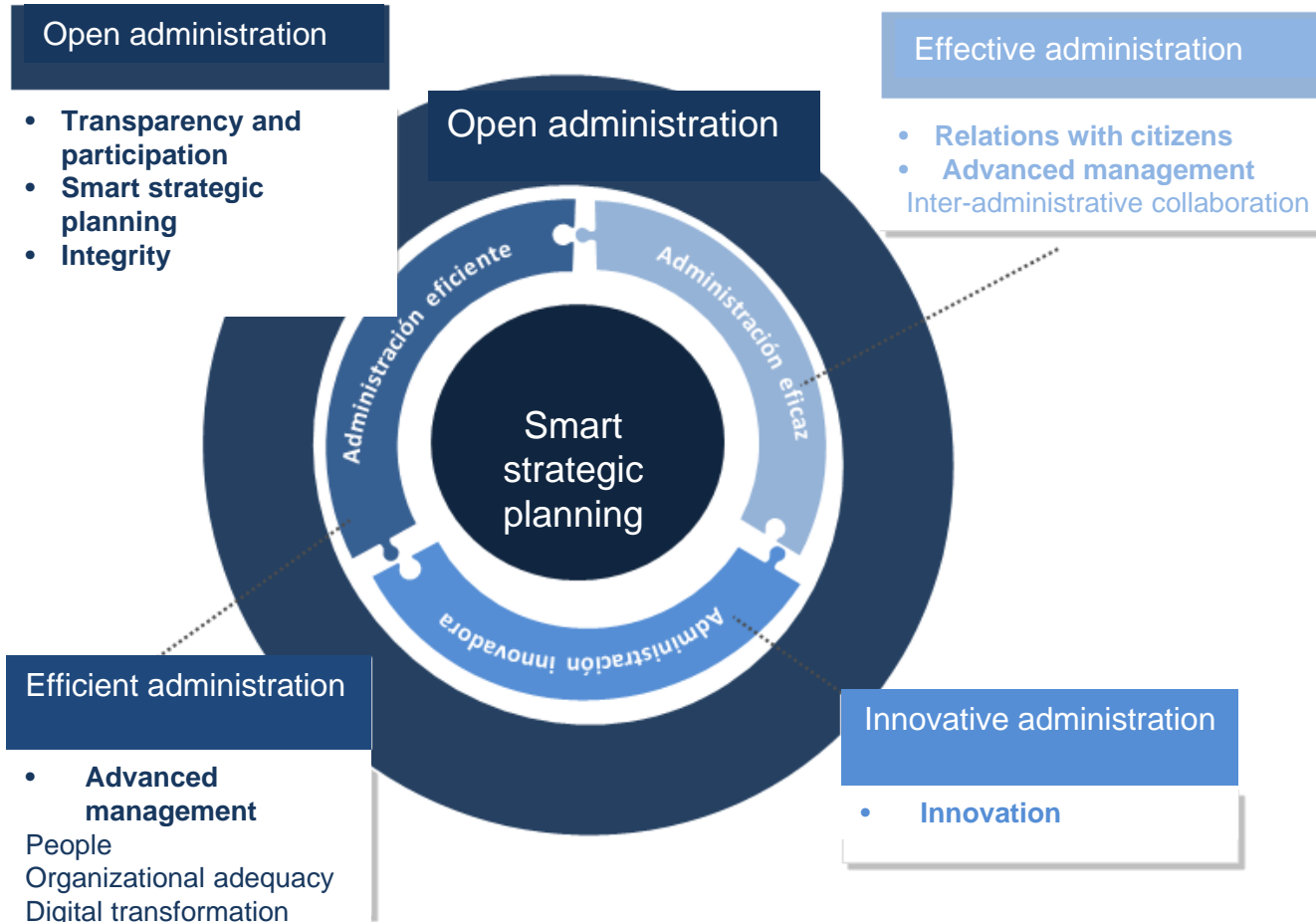
Improve the quality of actions, as they are the result of a debate of ideas and shared reflection.

PLAN 2018 - 2020 CO-DESIGNING A COMMON MODEL

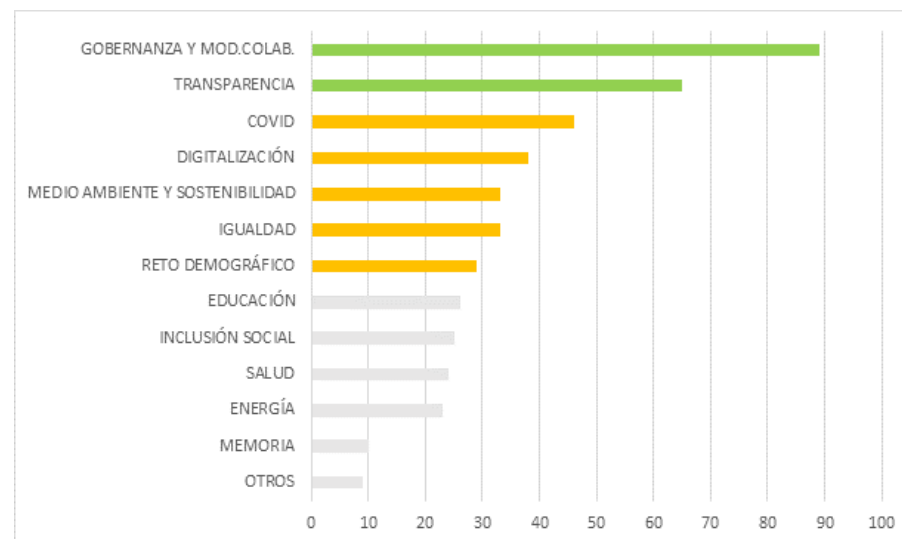
- K1** ACCOUNTABILITY → traceability

- K4** OPEN ESKOLA – training challenge
- K5** BASQUE SYSTEM OF INTEGRITY - values

NEW 2020 PLAN VERTICAL “POLICIES”

First phase - receipt of citizen proposals and thematic prioritization

Next phases:

- Expert panels (online)
- Selection of commitments
- Leadership and action design



We must set the HOWTOs

INSTRUMENTS, CAPACITIES AND SPACES that help us add up to shared objectives (e.g. to conserve and protect biodiversity - information for decision making).

In this process, we have developed two (guide + network) and we want to network these two lines of work:

TRAINING / CAPACITY BUILDING - PATHWAYS

- processes that recognize capacities, growth potential, mutual trust - training and accreditation system

COLLABORATION - IMPACT PROTOCOL

- Help us to contextualize our project (whatever link it is in) towards impact assessment (usually defined by law).
- Not losing sight of the objective, managing/targeting efforts, adopting accepted methodologies, making the whys explicit (with the vision of shared, not individual interest)
- Measuring what impact I have and what potential impact I can have - how to have a better impact
